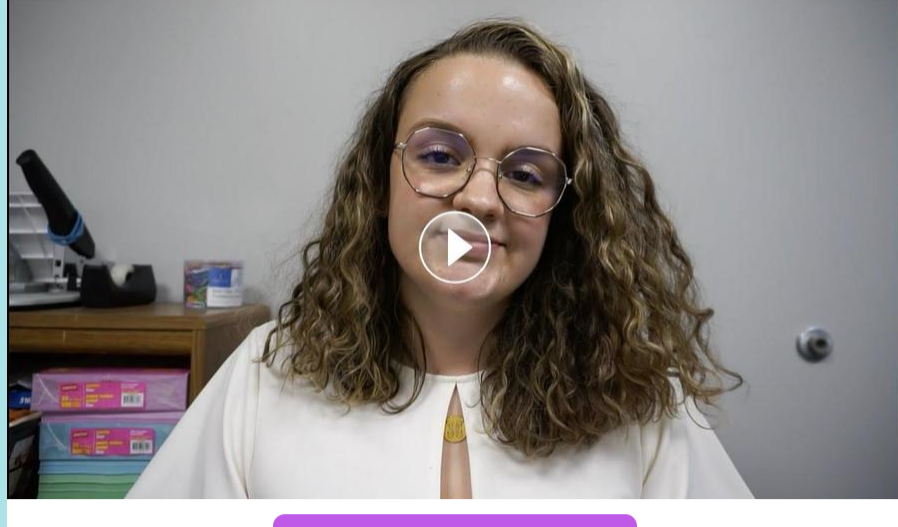

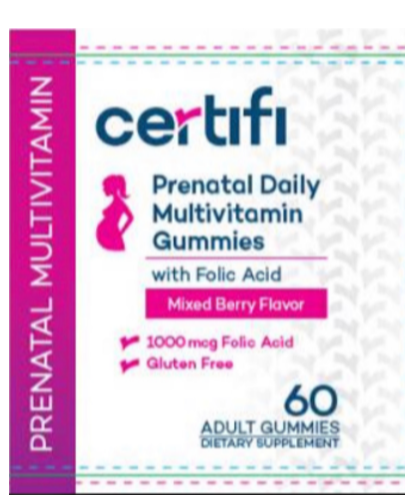

2021 application cycle is now open and posted on ODH's program webpage at <https://odh.ohio.gov/wps/portal/gov/odh/know-our-programs/primary-care-office/workforce-programs>

Potential sponsors for the 2021 application cycle should complete and submit the attached Notice of Intent to Apply form as soon as possible. **All applications must be postmarked by June 15, 2021.**

- Please be sure to note the application updates specified on the program webpage.
- Please thoroughly read application instructions and forms and be sure to use only the 2021 application forms. Check all documents for completeness, accuracy and consistency before submission. Do not submit additional materials unless requested.
- Applications from sponsors who submit more than one application will not be reviewed unless the same sponsor-identified representative is named on each application.
- Application reviews will include evaluation of the sponsor's adherence to program requirements for current and past participants.

COVID-19 Relief Aid Headed to Ohio; Here's What Your Community Will Receive

This local government spending is meant to help communities mitigate any budget losses suffered during the pandemic. The funding also serves as a stimulus to help them navigate the years ahead, [according to an analysis of the bill](#) from the National Conference of State Legislatures.

Money is able to be spent on COVID-19 needs; investments in local small businesses and nonprofits; offering premium pay to local "essential workers"; and infrastructure projects, such as water, sewer and broadband improvements.
