### Weitzman ECHO Series for Ohio: Comprehensive and Collaborative Care for Healthy Lifestyle Management and Diabetes

**Kick-off session: Monday February 8, 2021 at 12pm ET**

*Weitzman ECHO Comprehensive and Collaborative Care for Healthy Lifestyle Management and Diabetes* will use a multidisciplinary team of experts from *Ohio University* who will provide advice and guidance on a holistic approach to help solve patients' complex health needs related to diabetes and healthy lifestyle management.

This one year, 24-session ECHO will meet via Zoom on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Mondays of each month from 12-1pm ET to connect primary care providers and other care team members in Ohio to a community of peers and subject-matter experts.
